Accomplishments

- Serve as President of the City of Wichita Board of Park Commissioners (President, September 2016 – present; Board member, September 2009 – present); appointed by Council Member Janet Miller; accomplishments include:
 - Assisted in the update to the Park, Recreation, and Open Spaces (PROS) Plan to facilitate CaPRA (Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation Agencies) accreditation. The Park Department is the first City of Wichita department to achieve national accreditation
 - Reviewed and recommended the Aquatics Master Plan to City Council to ensure viability of the City-owned aquatics facilities
 - Supported a public/private partnership with Together Wichita to provide distance markers and directional signage—at no public cost—along Wichita's K-96 bicycle path
 - Reviewed and recommended Watson Park Master Plan to City Council to enhance park attractiveness and increase attendance

 - Listened to golfers and saved Clapp Golf Course from closing
